

INTRODUCTION:

" DESTROYERS FOR BASES, SWAP OF 1940" (THE FAMOUS FIFTY DESTROYERS OF WORLD WAR II)

DATA SHEET #7

By the middle of 1940 the battle of the Atlantic was raging. The British had suffered staggering destroyer losses to Axis forces. Britain's situation was desperate, it needed destroyers.

On September 2, 1940, a destroyer/naval and air base agreement was reached. Britain received 50 ageing World War I era destroyers. In exchange the United States was given the privilege of establishing bases in British territories in the Western hemisphere at Argentina (Newfoundland), Bermuda and Mariguana (Bermuda Islands), Jamaica and Trinidad (British West Indies), St. Lucia (Windward Islands), Antigua (Leeward Islands) and Georgetown (British Guiana).

Admiral of the Fleet, Sir James Somerville later wrote, "Had there been no American 'four stacker' destroyers available and had they not gone into service escorting trade convoy when they did, the outcome of the struggle against the U-Boat and the subsequent outcome of the European War itself might have been vastly different".

The Royal Navy rechristened the destroyers with names common to towns in both United Kingdom and the United States except for five of the original six destroyers assigned to the Royal Canadian Navy which were named after rivers.

Of the fifty destroyers, sixteen were manned by Canadians, five by the Royal Norwegian Navy, one by the Polish Navy, and nine were transferred to the Russian Navy in 1944 as partial substitution for one-third of the surrendered Italian Fleet.

One destroyer, the ex YARNALL DD-143 had the distinction during her career of serving under five flags---United States, British, Norwegian, Canadian and Russia.
