Landlocked Dallas to be site of major maritime museum From Undersen Warfare News David Flick, Dallas News, May 17

Plans are afoot to build a major maritime museum in Dallas. You heard right. The \$80 million Dallas Maritime Museum will be on a 3.5-acre site near the Trinity River, but more than 250 miles from the nearest body of salt water. Plans will be officially announced Friday morning by Mayor Mike Rawlings and members of a foundation formed to create the new facility. "Dallas is a city of big ideas, and this is just one more example," said Phillip Jones, president and CEO of the Dallas Convention and Visitors Bureau, which is backing the idea. "Lots of people are excited about this." One big idea is to acquire and display the 362-foot nuclear-powered attack submarine USS Dallas next to a 30,000-square-foot museum building. Foundation officials said naval authorities have approved the transfer once the vessel is removed from active duty. The submarine scheduled for decommissioning in 2014. It would be another 21/2 years before the vessel is ready

for public display. "By that time we want to have the museum ready," said John Shellene, the foundation's executive director.

"We're in the early stage of the fundraising process." Shellene said the money will largely come from private sources, though he said backers may apply to the city for additional funding.
