beaumontenterprise.com N.D. (AP) The BISMARCK, commissioning of a new attack submarine that will become USS North Dakota SSN-784 has been rescheduled. KXMB-TV reports that the commissioning for the \$2.6 billion vessel will be held on Oct. 25 at the Navy shipyard in Groton, Connecticut. The U S Navy says an earlier commissioning set for May was postponed because additional work was required on the bow of a new attack submarine.
