This list joins over forty USCS Data Sheets created and/or compiled over the years to aid collectors of naval covers to explore areas on which to build a collection and develop a navophilatelic exhibit.

The Medal of Honor is the highest military decoration that may be awarded by the United States government. It is presented by the President of the United States, in the name of Congress, and is conferred only upon members of the United States Armed Forces who distinguish themselves through conspicuous gallantry and intrepidity at the risk of life above and beyond the call of duty:

While engaged in action against an enemy of the United States;

While engaged in military operations involving conflict with an opposing foreign force; or

While serving with friendly foreign forces engaged in an armed conflict against an opposing armed force in which the United States is not a belligerent party.

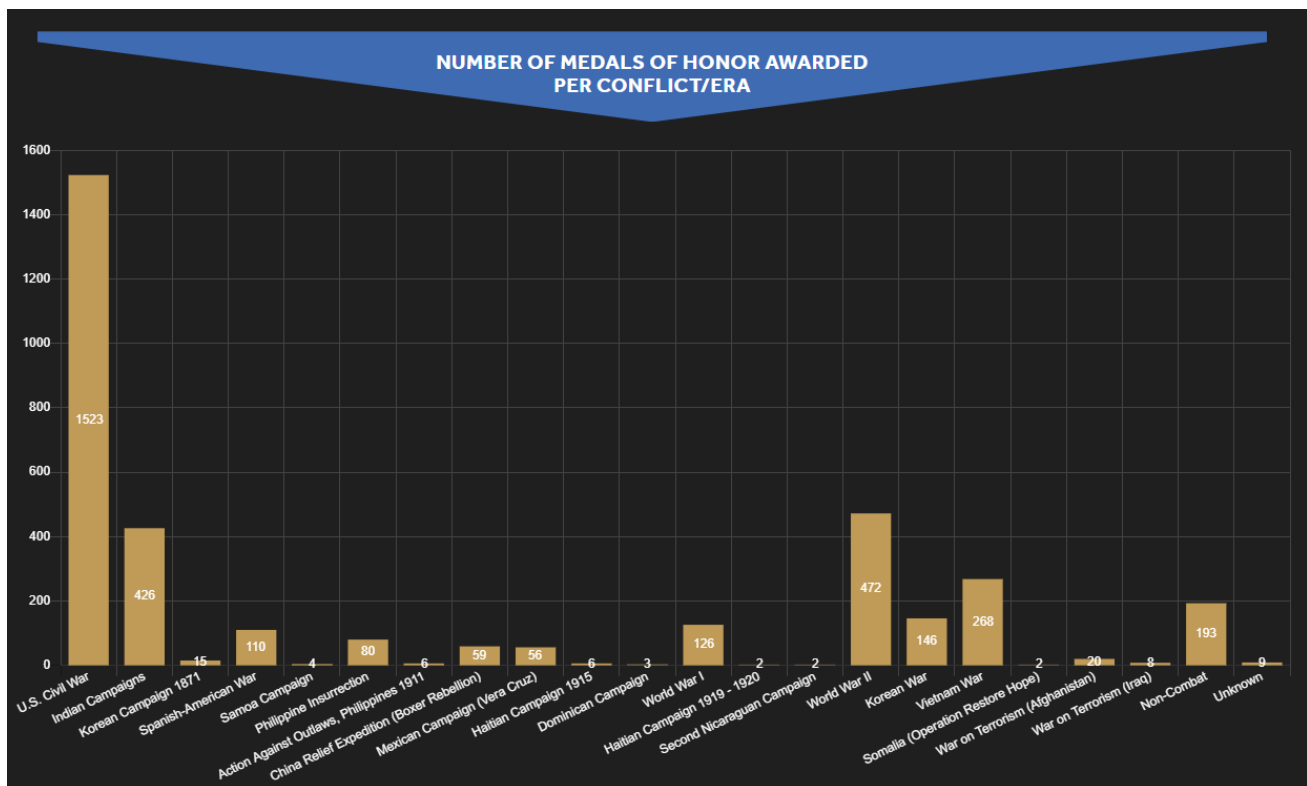
## Ships Named for Medal of Honor Recipients

### Introduction:

The Medal of Honor was created during the American Civil War and is the highest military decoration presented by the United States government to a member of its armed forces. The recipient must have distinguished themselves at the risk of their own life above and beyond the call of duty in action against an enemy of the United States. Due to the nature of this medal, it is commonly presented posthumously. The President of the United States, in the name of the United States Congress, has awarded more than 3,536 Medals of Honor including 19 second awards to the nation's soldiers, sailors, airmen, marines, and coast guardsmen since the decoration's creation in 1861. **Note:** The name of the medal is Medal of Honor and it is often erroneously referred to as the Congressional Medal of Honor; however, it is purely a military award created by Congress.

As of this project, there have been 2,458 Army awards and 749 Navy Awards. There have been 300 Marine Corps awards, 19 Air Force awards and 1 Coast Guard award. The chart below shows the number of awards for every conflict/era.

This data sheet compiles the names of Medal of Honor recipients who have had United States naval ships named for them. You will note that several ships have been recently named for MOH recipients and are still in early construction; therefore, there is no launch or commissioning dates given. A column at the far right identifies the month and year of a detailed article of the history of the recipient and the named ship that has been printed in a *USCS Log*.
